**SPEAKER: Ed Sachs, Mission Viejo  
Mayor Pro-Tem**

**Topic: Israel, the Middle East and Us –  
What does the future hold?**

Ed Sachs, Mayor Pro-Tem of Mission Viejo, will discuss how the passage of UN Resolution 2334 will shape future relations between the U.S. and Israel. # A Tax in California Has Actually Been Lowered?

**D**id you resolve to pay lower taxes in 2017? Effective Jan. 1, 2017, the sales and use tax rate dropped in California one-quarter of 1 percent, from 7.50 percent to 7.25 percent. The lower tax rate is good news for consumers and the result of the partial expiration of Proposition 30, a 2012 initiative that sought higher income and sales taxes.

Shoppers in some cities may pay more than 7.25 percent because of local sales taxes higher than the state rate.

If you bought something before Jan. 1 and need to return it, the store must provide you with a refund for the old tax rate. And, if you bought something before Jan. 1 that wasn't delivered until after the New Year, the old tax rate remains applicable. Retailers should adjust their operations to charge the current 7.25 percent sales tax starting January 1, 2017, unless a higher sales tax is present in their area.

A retailer who continues to charge and collect the higher statewide sales and use tax after January 1, 2017, must either refund the excess tax collected to their customer or pay the excess tax to the Board of Equalization (BOE). If the excess tax collected has been paid to the BOE, the retailer may request a refund on behalf of their customer by completing form BOE-101, Claim for Refund or Credit.

For merchandise delivered after January 1, 2017, the applicable sales and use tax rate is the rate that is in effect at the time the sale occurs. Generally, the sale occurs when the merchandise is delivered to the customer, unless the sales contract specifically states that title to the merchandise passes to the customer prior to delivery.

With returned merchandise, the customer should be refunded the amount of tax at the rate that was charged and collected from the customer at the time of the original sale. ## Federation Members Make History in the Electoral College

**N**FRW members helped make history when the Electoral College met on December 19th. Despite an organized pressure campaign from the left, Democrats had more Electors defect from **Hillary Clinton** than Republican had Electors who did not support **Donald Trump** (and on January 3, more Democrats deserted **Nancy Pelosi** than Republicans who didn't support **Paul Ryan** for Speaker).

NFRW Legislative Committee Chairman **Martha Jenkins**, an Elector from North Carolina, shares her experience:

“Little did I know when I decided to run for Presidential Elector in April of 2016 what lay in store. The weekend after the election I started getting emails asking me to ‘vote my conscience.’ It was a trickle at first, but I could tell that an organized effort was taking place to overturn the will of the people. They all used the same talking points and, through conversations with other Electors from NC and NFRW members I knew from around the country who were Electors, we realized we were all experiencing the same thing. At first I responded, but soon it was impossible because of the sheer volume.

Most of the letters referred to **Alexander Hamilton** and argued that the ‘sole’ purpose of the Electoral College was to make sure someone unqualified didn't make it to the office of the Presidency. Little did they know that, as a history major, I knew that the Electoral College was set up to keep the larger states from dominating the smaller ones. Thank goodness for the Founders’ ‘Great Compromise.’ Without it, the huge majority Clinton got in California alone would have decided our presidential election and the majority of states would have no say in who is elected President. This election was a good example of why the Founders did what they did, and it also served as a great opportunity to educate folks on why the Electoral College is important.

A week or so before we met, the campaign intensified. I started getting letters in my mailbox at home and at work, as well as phone calls. In three-days time, I got over 1,000 pieces of mail asking me to switch my vote, or abstain. Those who know me know that nothing could have made me change my vote, even if it had been legal for me to do so. All of the efforts of the left only made me more determined to cast my Electoral vote for **Donald Trump**.

On December 19, the North Carolina Electors met at the N.C. Museum of History and walked to the State Capitol singing ‘God Bless America.’ The protesters were there, but their presence did nothing to take away from the solemnity of the occasion. We met in the old NC House of Representatives Chamber and ceremonially did our duty by unanimously casting our votes for **Donald Trump** for President and **Mike Pence** for Vice President. It was a surreal feeling to be such an important part of history and realize that Electors had met every four years to perform their constitutional duty in the very same place - and a proud moment.”
